

Fun Flight Facts

- ◆ The Wright brothers invented and flew the first airplane in 1903. It is considered the world's first "sustained and controlled heavier-than-air powered flight." Their aircraft, the Wright Flyer, flew about 120 feet.
- Stewardesses is the longest word in the English language typed with just the left hand.
- ♦ KLM is the worlds' oldest airline, established in 1919. It's first flight between Amsterdam and London took place on May 17th, 1920.
- ◆ In 1987 American Airlines saved \$40,000 by removing one olive from each salad served in first class.
- Air travel is the second safest form of transportation. Only the elevator/escalator is safer, although it would take quite some time to travel 1,000 miles on an escalator.



- ◆ `MAYDAY' is derived from the French word m'aidez, which means help me.
- ♦ A Boeing 747s wing-span is longer than the Wright Brothers first flight (120ft).
- The internet and on-line check-in was first used by Alaska Airlines in 1999.
- ◆ The first women flight attendants in the 1930's were required to weigh no more than 115 pounds, be nurses and un-married.
- ♦ 75% of all inflight arguments between grown adults are a result of economy passengers reclining their seats.

Now That's Old!

- ⇒ The oldest cat ever is Creme Puff born August 3rd 1967 and died August 6th 2005 - 38 years and 3 days! Creme Puff lived with her owner, Jake Perry, in Austin, Texas.
- ⇒ The oldest animal ever known lived from 1499 until the day researchers cracked its shell open in 2006, killing it in the process. Ming, an ocean quahog from the species Arctica Islandica, was an incredible 507 years old, reports CBS.
- ⇒ Jeanne Calment lived to the age of 122 years, 164 days, becoming the oldest recorded human who ever lived. She died on August 4, 1997.
- ⇒ Lin Wang, an Asian elephant, was the oldest elephant in the Taipei Zoo. He was born in January 18, 1917, and died in February 26, 2003, at 86 years.
- ⇒ A greater flamingo, named Greater, died at Adelaide Zoo in January 2014 at the age of at least 83.
- ⇒ Thaao, an Andean condor, died at the age of 80.
- ⇒ Cookie, (hatched June 30, 1933) an Australian-born Major Mitchell's cockatoo resident at Brookfield Zoo, Illinois, was the oldest member of his species in captivity, and died in August 2016 at a verified age of 83.
- ⇒ A female Laysan albatross named Wisdom successfully laid an egg at Midway Atoll in December 2016, at the age of 66. As of 2017, she is the oldest known wild bird in the world.

Grandma's Saturday Morning French Toast

4 eggs 6 slices bread - day-old or slightly stale works well

1 c. milk butter

1/8 tsp. salt powdered sugar &/or maple syrup

1 tsp. sugar

1/2 tsp. cinnamon

1/2 tsp. vanilla



In a medium-size mixing bowl, beat eggs, milk, salt, sugar, cinnamon, and vanilla with a fork or whisk until well mixed. Preheat a non-stick griddle or pan over medium heat. Add 1-2 tsp. butter to griddle just until melted/spread over entire griddle, then start to add bread, as below.

Immerse bread on both sides into the egg mixture one at a time and place on the hot, buttered griddle. Cook for about 3 minutes, or until the bottom is nicely brown, then flip and cook on the other side for a couple minutes until brown. Serve immediately topped with butter and powdered sugar &/or maple syrup.
