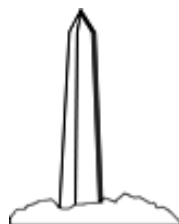

Then two guys walked into the same restaurant. Looking around for a table one said, "Hey, look, isn't that the jerk who got in the car when we were pushing it?"

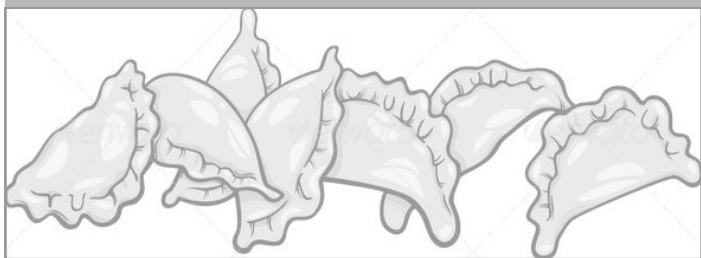
Pierogi Casserole

- 1 lb Velveeta cheese
- 2 sticks of margarine
- 1 1/2 cups of milk
- 1 medium chopped onion
- 2 packages instant mashed potatoes
- 16 ounce bag bowtie noodles

Melt cheese, margarine, milk, and onion together in the microwave.

Cook bowtie noodles and instant potatoes according to directions on their boxes.

Grease large casserole dish. Put 1/2 of noodles in the dish and pour 1/2 of cheese mixture over noodles. Spread mashed potatoes over noodles. Put remaining noodles over potatoes and pour remaining cheese mixture over the noodles. Bake at 350° for 30-45 minutes until bubbly.
