### Beam Me Up!

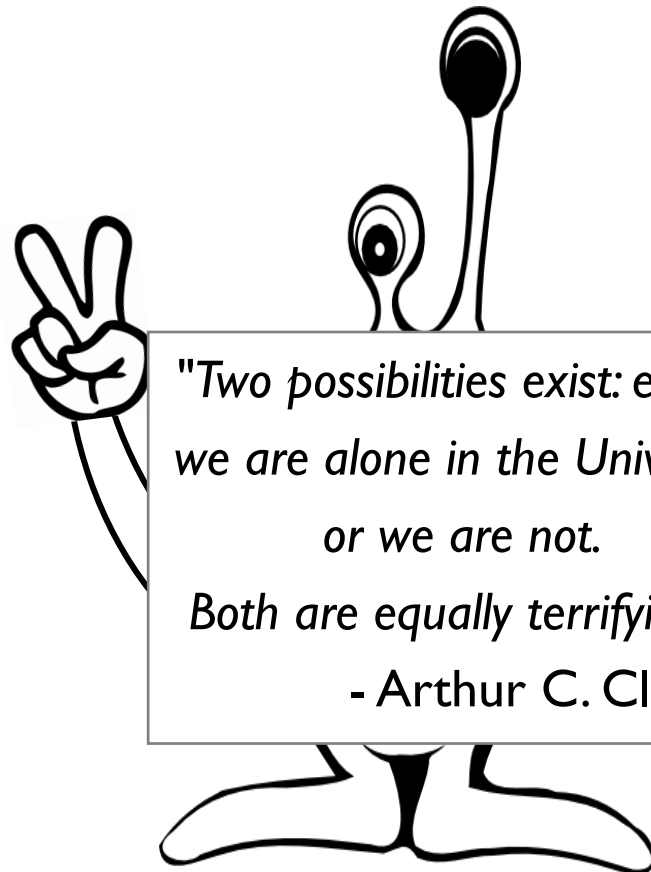

All this seems to point to the fact that we should have more barbeque picnics and fireworks shows over a longer period of time.

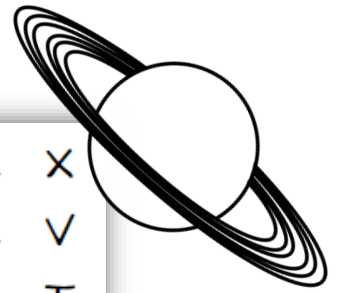

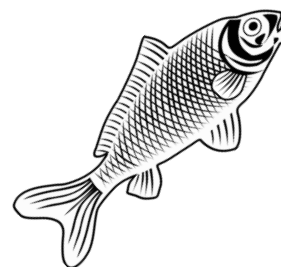
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## Broiled Parmesan Cod

- 3½ oz. grated Parmesan cheese
- ½ stick butter, softened
- 3 TBSP mayonnaise
- 2 TBSP lemon juice, fresh
- 1 TBSP fresh basil, finely chopped
- ¼ tsp pepper
- ½ tsp salt
- 2 pounds cod fillets\*



Line large baking (jelly roll) pan with foil.

In a bowl, combine all ingredients except cod. Mix well and set aside.

Arrange fish in a single layer on the prepared pan and place under the broiler on high for 2 to 3 minutes.

Flip the fillets over and broil for a couple more minutes. Remove from the oven and cover them with the Parmesan cheese mixture on the top side only.

Broil for 2 more minutes or until the topping is browned and fish flakes easily with a fork. Be careful not to overcook the fish.

\*may use most white fish or salmon, as well
