On the second day, the Corps issued him a comb. That afternoon, a Navy barber shaved his head.

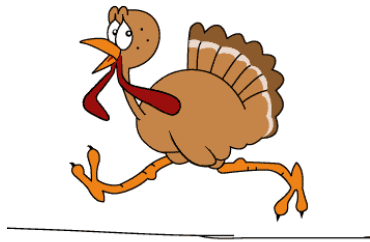
On the third day, he was issued a jock strap.....

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Pumpkin Spice Monkey Bread

This is enough to share with your friends!

- 2 – 16.3 ounce cans refrigerated biscuits
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 1 teaspoon cinnamon
- 1 teaspoon pumpkin pie spice
- 1/2 cup pumpkin puree (not pumpkin pie mix)
- 1 cup (2 sticks) butter, melted
- 1 1/4 cup brown sugar

Preheat oven to 350°F. Cut each biscuit into quarters.

In a large zip-close bag, combine sugar, cinnamon, and pumpkin pie spice. Add the pieces of dough to the bag and shake well to coat.

Well grease a fluted or a Bundt cake pan. Arrange half of the biscuit pieces loosely in the pan.

In a small bowl combine melted butter with brown sugar and pumpkin. Pour half of the mixture over the monkey bread. Add remaining biscuit pieces then pour remaining over top.

Bake for 30-32 minutes or until the top is golden brown and the dough is cooked through.

Allow the monkey bread to cool for 10 minutes, then carefully flip the pan upside down onto a large serving plate. Delicious warm or cool.
